GMC Caballero lets you enjoy passenger car comfort in a pickup truck. Standard interior features include: color-keyed trim for the headliner, newly styled instrument panel, sunshades, steering column, steering wheel, seat trim and cut-pile carpeting. Also standard are lighted ashtray and glove compartment, door-activated courtesy lights, Deluxe-air heater/defroster, cigarette lighter, door trim panels with integral armrests and door pull straps, and concealed storage for luggage and spare tire behind the driver's seat.

Standard deep-foam bench seats are upholstered in Dark Blue, Camel, or Maroon cloth—or vinyl in the same colors plus Champagne (Champagne not available for Diablo). Seats include color-keyed safety belts.

Available cloth or vinyl Strato bucket seats come in the same color selection as standard bench seats. To complete the sporty picture, you can add available gage package with available simulated wood-grain-trimmed console with transmission shift lever and storage compartment.

New available 55/45 split bench seat, in the same color cloth or vinyl material as standard bench seat, includes an upholstered fold-down armrest at the split.

NEW FRONT END STYLING, NEW VALUE FOR '81

Caballero's traditional imposing beauty is enhanced by a new grille design, new parking lamps, new headlamp bezels and a new design for the standard wheel covers. Inside there is a new-style instrument panel, new international symbols for instrument control knobs and control panel. There is new seat trim for '81 and door pull straps are now standard.

The new Freedom II battery is standard. A handy side lift jack replaces the bumper type. And new high-pressure P205/75R radial tires help reduce rolling resistance.

CABALLERO STANDARD FEATURES

Caballero is loaded with standard features. Ask your GMC Dealer to give you an idea of what is standard for Caballero in '81!

Outside: Rectangular headlamps; bright moldings; recessed windshield wipers; bright roof drip moldings; new-style full wheel covers; rear-bumper-mounted tail and backup lamps; Caballero identification; double-panel construction of door, hood, front fenders, pickup box sides and tailgate; acrylic lacquer finish, bright chromed bumpers and more.

Inside: Full carpet floor covering; controlled power flow-through ventilation system; foam-cushioned seat; ashtray; heater/

defroster system; dual padded sunvisors; energy-absorbing steering column; new-style, color-coordinated instrument panel pad; anti-theft ignition key warning buzzer and steering column lock; and inside hood release.

Operating and chassis features: Tough exhaust system; Freedom II battery; Delcotron alternator; computer-selected, full-coil suspension system with wear indicator on front lower ball joints; self-adjusting, power assisted disc/drum power brakes with audible wear indicator, power steering and engine coolant recovery system.

Capacity: Caballero can carry a payload of 1,250 lbs.

NEW COMPUTER COMMAND CONTROL EMISSION SYSTEM

All 1981 engines for GMC Caballero are equipped with this exciting new computer-controlled system that reduces Caballero's emissions to the lowest level in GMC history. Space-age technology employs an on-board computer, an oxygen sensor, other engine sensors, and an electromechanical fuel metering system in the carburetor to control the ratio of fuel/air induction. The system is also engineered so the engine will continue to function in the event of a computer malfunction.

GM Continuous Protection Plan. This option offers service protection in addition to that provided by GM's new vehicle limited warranty. Ask your dealer about it. (Available only in USA and Canada during the 1981 model year.)

The GMC Caballeros described in this brochure are assembled at facilities of General Motors Corporation operated by GM Chevrolet Motor Division or GM of Canada. These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by various divisions of General Motors and by various suppliers to General Motors. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce GMC products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in GMC products and will provide the

quality performance associated with the GMC name.

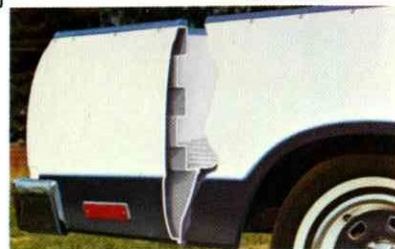
CABALLERO DIABLO

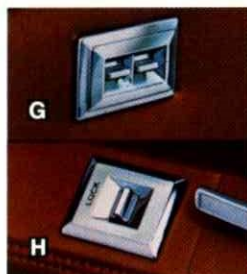
