The XLT Lariat, the top of the line, is offered in every model except the Chassis-Cab.



Standard instrumentation includes a voltmeter plus a complement of critical gauges — fuel, oil pressure and engine temperature — which can be easily viewed at a quick glance through an A-shaped steering hub.


XLT LARIAT INTERIOR



Not only does it seat six, but with the standard rear bench seat folded down, you'll have over 31 cubic feet of cargo area to carry everything from beverage coolers to golf clubs, tool boxes, groceries, suitcases — you name it — right there inside the cab within easy reach.

SUPERCAB STYLE AND COMFORT

SuperCab is available in all three trim levels, with standard features that include tinted glass, fully-trimmed interior, color-keyed cloth headliner and dual fuel tanks.

For added luxury, choose the optional Captain's Chairs, trimmed in cloth with reclining seat backs and inboard folding armrests. Captain's Chairs include tip/slide seat tracks for easy entry and exit plus a locking floor console for additional storage.

CREW CAB VERSATILITY

Available in 2WD (single and dual rear wheels) and 4WD (single rear wheels only) configurations, the F-Series Crew Cab is designed for full-size versatility. Notable features include: Seating for six □ Four doors for easy exit and entry □ 8-foot pickup box □ Standard V-8 power □ Optional diesel power □ Dual fuel tanks, and more.

Two full-width bench seats provide riding comfort. Bright low mount swingaway mirrors, cargo lamp, tinted glass and full cloth headliner, plus fully trimmed interior are among the many standard features. Notable options include power door locks/front windows and XLT Lariat trim.


THE CHOICE IS YOURS

F-Series 4x4 pickups are available in four series and three cab styles: F-150 Regular and SuperCab, F-250 Regular Cab, F-250 HD Regular and SuperCab plus the F-350 Regular and Crew Cab.

Depending on the model, you can equip your 4x4 with engines ranging from the standard 4.9 liter EFI I-6 to the 7.5L EFI V-8. And transmissions from the 5-speed manual overdrive to a 4-speed automatic overdrive. (See page 20 for specifica-

tions.) The choice is yours.

MANUAL OR AUTOMATIC LOCKING HUBS

Manual or automatic locking hubs? Each has its advantages. Again, with the Ford F-Series, the choice is yours.

More than likely, the 4x4 "mud and guts" enthusiast will opt for the standard manual locking hubs. It fits the image and life style of the no-nonsense, dependable off-road truck.

F-Series standard manual locking front hubs are the free-running type. In the 2WD mode with the hubs unlocked, the front axles and driveshaft remain relatively motionless, reducing friction and wear.

For added convenience, the F-150 series offers optional automatic locking hubs. Introduced into the F-Series in 1981, automatic locking hubs are simple to operate. Merely stop the vehicle, put it into neutral,

then shift into 4-wheel drive. The hubs lock automatically.

Once the hub locks are engaged, you can shift from 4-wheel drive high to 2-wheel drive and back at any normal road speed.

STANDARD SUSPENSIONS

The Ford 4x4 Pickup is equipped with the type of suspension systems you'd expect in a tough off-road vehicle.

The Twin-Traction-Beam independent front suspension (monobeam front axle on the F-350) and gas-pressurized shock absorbers are designed to deliver a smooth ride plus positive off-road control.

HEAVY-DUTY OPTIONS

The F-Series 4x4 offers the kind of heavy-duty options that allows you to build your truck to your specific set of requirements:

- Handling package
- Heavy-duty front and rear suspension packages
- Skid plate package
- Limited slip front or rear axles
- Recommended equipment for snow plow installation

- Camper/Trailer towing package
- Ambulance prep package. (See your Ford Dealer for package contents and restrictions.)

Once you've taken a good look at the F-Series 4x4, one thing is clear — if you can't get there in a Ford Pickup, maybe you shouldn't go.

FORD CHASSIS-CAB

F-Series Chassis-Cabs are designed to accommodate custom bodies and are engineered to handle the top end of light truck applications.

The F-Super Duty Chassis-Cab (2WD) heads this tough lineup with a 14,500 lb. GVWR and 137/161-inch wheelbases. It's powered by the 7.5 liter V-8 with a 7.3 liter V-8 diesel option. GCWRs

for towing applications go up to an impressive 22,000 pounds with the 7.5 liter engine, and 17,000 pounds with the diesel. The F-Super Duty is spec'd out with a 5,000-pound GAWR monobeam front axle and 11,000-pound rear axle. Four-wheel disc brakes are standard.

The F-350 2WD and 4WD Chassis-Cabs are available in three wheelbases and GVWRs up to 11,000 pounds.

NEW FOR 1989: F-SUPER DUTY MOTORHOME AND COMMERCIAL STRIPPED CHASSIS MODELS

Ford has significantly expanded its stripped chassis line for 1989 with the addition of 16,000-pound GVWR F-Super Duty models for commercial and motorhome applications.

The Commercial Stripped Chassis is powered by a stan-

dard 7.3L diesel combined with a close-ratio 5-speed manual overdrive transmission. The standard Motorhome Stripped Chassis features a 7.5L EFI engine plus the E4OD transmission (late availability). Both are equipped with 4-wheel power disc brakes.

PICKUP TRUCK BUYER'S GUIDE

Your choice of trucks will most likely be determined by your payload or camper/trailer towing requirements. The Ford F-Series offers a pickup for virtually every personal and commercial application from the popular F-150 to the F-350.

This Pickup Truck Buyer's Guide lays out the basic configurations and trims available within the F-Series. The selection process is simple.

After you've identified the series — F-150/F-250/F-250HD/F-350 — that will handle your requirements, run down the left column to find which cab styles, trim levels, bed lengths and

Payloads, camper/trailer towing capacities and gross vehicle weights are listed at maximum ratings for each series and drive type. Maximum ratings for individual models within each series will vary. Be sure to talk to your Ford salesperson in selecting the

right truck for the job.

NEW FOR 1989 — ELECTRONICALLY CONTROLLED AUTOMATIC OVERDRIVE TRANSMISSION (E4OD)*

Rear anti-lock braking — a Ford first for full-size light trucks — was introduced into the F-Series in 1987. This electronically controlled system is designed to prevent rear wheel lockup under most 2WD operating conditions.

You've more than likely been taught to pump your brakes when stopping on slick surfaces.






Rear anti-lock braking operates on the same principle. In effect, it applies and releases pressure to the rear brakes, only faster, with computer controlled efficiency.

A computer continuously monitors the system for malfunction. Should malfunction occur, an instrument-panel warning light tells the driver that the computer has shut the system down and returned the rear brakes to conventional operation.

The E4OD 4-speed automatic overdrive is Ford truck's first fully electronically controlled transmission. The E4OD was designed to achieve improved fuel economy, performance and "shift feel" over vacuum controlled transmissions. The E4OD is offered in select trucks rated at 8,500-pounds GVW and over.

A real plus, the E4OD features an Overdrive Cancel Switch — mounted on the instrument panel — cancels upshift to the overdrive gear at the operator's discretion. This is particularly useful in city traffic or in heavy-duty applications like trailer towing.
